

## General Information

- All financial responsibilities will be coordinated through your Director.
- Complete payment schedule is available from your Director.
- Final itinerary with hotel name, address, and phone number, will be sent to the Director two weeks prior to departure if final payment has been received.
- Classic Festivals is designed for a student's budget and, as such, include quadruple occupancy. Adults are welcome to participate on our programs. However, adults should be aware that they will be charged an "Adult Supplement" to cover the cost of a double room and the higher adult rates charged for scheduled tours and activities.
- Participants are financially responsible for their own hotel room service, phone calls, and other personal expenses. These charges must be cleared from your hotel room bill the night before departure.
- Participants are responsible for damages and/or losses they cause while on the tour.
- Airline tickets (where applicable) will be mailed to the Director when total group payment is received.

## Participant Guidelines

1. Room assignments will be made by the Director. (No room changes are made without approval of your Director.)
2. You are expected to participate in all scheduled activities. Directors and chaperones will check to see that participants are present at all activities and at meal times.
3. CF and the Director will establish rules and directions for all participants.
4. Curfew will be set daily for evening bedtime. Room check will be made nightly.
5. You must be on time for all scheduled departures and activities as listed on your final day-by-day itinerary.
6. No participant should leave the hotel without first checking with his/her Director or official chaperone. Participants are expected to honor the "buddy system." Never go anywhere alone.
7. There will be no drinking of alcohol by participants under the age of twenty-one (21).
8. Absolutely no illegal drugs, smoking, or vulgar language are permitted.
9. You are responsible to your Director 24 hours a day from departure to return. You are to remain with your group at all times unless you have specific permission from your Director to be away from the group. Remember, you will not be at home in the relative safety of your neighborhood; avoid dark streets, alleys, hotel stairways, etc. Be careful in all you do.
10. Reasonable, positive, responsible conduct is required at all times. Attitudes are infectious. In the event a participant does not comply with rules or directions, the participant may be sent home at his/her own expense. Parents of students will receive a phone call from the Director, notifying them of the action taken.
11. Inappropriate behavior or dancing will not be tolerated at banquet.

## Terms of Participation

1. Classic Festivals (CF) is responsible to participants in making arrangements for all services included in the program. Each participant (and the parents or guardians for participants under 21), however, by signing the application, releases CF, its directors, officers, or employees from any and all claims of any nature whatsoever from any injury, loss, damage, cost, accident, delay, irregularity, or expenses arising out of the performance or operation of an CF program except for any such claim arising out of intentional or reckless acts of the directors, officers, or employees of CF in the scope of their employment. Any film or video likeness taken of a participant and any comment or statement made by him/her while taking part in a CF Program may be used in materials published by CF without compensation.
2. CF cannot be responsible for events beyond its control, such as, without limitation, acts of God, strikes, government restrictions, or for acts or omissions of persons not controlled by it, such as, without limitation, travel services, suppliers, transportation, hotels or sightseeing, and hotels. I agree to release CF, its agents and employees, and my local school and my Director from all claims arising out of such events, acts, or omissions.

3. I grant to CF the right to take whatever action it deems necessary in regard to my health and safety including, without limitation, obtaining medical treatment on my behalf and transporting me at my own or my parents' expense back to my home for medical reasons.
4. I understand that CF and the Director will establish rules and directions for all participants. I understand that my failure to comply with such rules may entail my termination as a participant and my return home at my own or my parents' expense, with no subsequent refund from CF. I understand that participants under the age of twenty-one (21) are not permitted to use or have in their possession alcoholic beverages of any kind or illegal or narcotic drugs (other than those lawfully prescribed by a licensed physician). Possession of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is grounds for immediate dismissal of the participant and return home of that participant by the first available transportation at the expense of the participant or the participant's parents. I understand that CF is not responsible for my well-being when I am absent from CF-supervised activities or on a visit to friends or relatives.
5. I will indemnify CF, its agents, and employees, and hold them harmless, for any financial liability or obligation which I personally incur, or injury or damage to the person or property of others which I cause or contribute to, while participating in a CF program.
6. CF programs which travel by air are generally booked on promotional airfares. These fares have certain restrictions regarding reservations and cancellations. I understand that if I cancel my reservation after my ticket has been issued by the air carrier, I must forfeit the amount of the airline cancellation penalty in addition to other cancellation penalties listed below. I understand that these airfares are subject to increase at any time prior to purchase.
7. I understand that the air carrier's liability for loss of or damage to baggage or property, or for the death or injury to the person or for delay or other changes in planned flights is limited by their tariffs, or the Warsaw Convention or both.
8. The programs offered have been designed by CF many months in advance of departure. I therefore grant CF the unqualified right to alter, amend, or cancel such programs and to make any adjustment to program cost prior to departure in order to meet unanticipated contingencies, including any change in transportation costs, program cost, international exchange rates, or lack of participation in the program, I understand such changes in the program, including increases in program prices based on these changes, are not grounds for cancellation without penalty.
9. I understand that if I wish to cancel my reservation on a CF program, I must do so IN WRITING. Upon cancellation, I will be entitled to a refund of my payments under the terms indicated below.
  - a) If I cancel my reservation at least forty-five (45) days prior to departure, CF will refund all amounts paid, less a \$25.00 processing fee per person and all applicable airline and other cancellation fees.
  - b) If I cancel my reservation less than forty-five (45) days prior to departure, I will forfeit 50% of the program price plus all applicable airline and other cancellation fees,
  - c) If I cancel my reservation less than 7 days prior to departure, no refund is given,
  - d) If the program is cancelled by CF, the participant shall be entitled to a full refund of all amounts paid.
10. I certify that I have read the CF General information and agree that all terms and conditions stated therein are fully incorporated in this agreement. I further understand that this agreement will be effective only upon my acceptance by CF as a program participant.
11. There will be no refunds, and/or substitutions for services, meals, sight-seeing, accommodations, or transportation (including air fare) missed or not used by participants for any reason, once the program has begun.
12. The law of the state of Utah shall govern as to all aspects of the terms and conditions and performance hereunder. In the event of any claim, dispute or legal action arising out of or related to the trip, the parties consent and submit to the exclusive venue and jurisdiction of any court of the State of Utah or the United States of America sitting in Utah.
