



PAYMENT STATEMENT FOR WSHS MARCHING BAND

No student shall ever be excluded from participating in the Mighty Viking Marching Band Program because of payment constraints. The band boosters offer various opportunities to pay the fees associated with participating in Marching Band to help alleviate some of the financial burden. Listed below are the opportunities that are offered:

- 1) Student/parent participation in fundraising efforts. Throughout the school year the band boosters will present various fundraisers that will allow the students to earn money for their student accounts. These funds can be put towards the marching band fees.
- 2) Provide the parent with a payment schedule that must be paid by August 11, 2011.
- 3) Provide the parent with a payment contract that is approved by the Treasurer and President, is considered in hardship situations, and is strictly confidential.
- 4) Provide PayPal and credit card payment options.

Marching Band Fees and Payment Schedule:

Initial commitment form with a non-refundable \$75 deposit	June 16 and 28, 2011
Final Payment due	August 11, 2011

Returning Marcher Fee: \$350 – this includes music, drill, instruction, uniform, and show shirt
 New Marcher Fee: \$400 – this includes all of the above and marching shoes and wind suit
 Color Guard: an additional fee of \$10 for equipment rental needs to be added to your fee above

Please be aware that any returned or bounced check will result in a \$40.00 fee. The fee, as well as the amount of the initial check, will need to be paid in cash or by money order within one week of being notified of the returned/bounced check.

By signing this payment statement, I _____ the parent of _____ have read and understand the above payment statement. If I fail to make payments on time, I understand my student's name will be submitted to the school administration which will result in my student not being allowed to participate in Prom, Graduation, or any other school sponsored function until this debt is paid in full. I understand I have several payment options and if I feel I cannot adhere to the initial payment plan, I can set up a payment agreement that will allow me the opportunity to pay my fees through the end of marching band season. I understand this type of payment plan will require approval by the Treasurer and President of the Band Boosters. I understand that I must comply with all effective **DUE DATES** as noted in any of the payment plans. If I cannot adhere to the agreed upon payment plan dates, I must notify the Treasurer and President in writing one week prior to the due date.
